CSA News and Events

A significant change for this season is the reorganization of the CSA Management structure. This year the Whole Village CSA will be co-managed by Graham Corbett, Aerron Kirby, and Adrienne LaChapelle. If you have any questions for the new management team, please do not hesitate to contact us.

Another change regards the pick-up process. **Members will now have a choice of pick up days and locations.** Members can choose to pick-up on Tuesdays at Whole Village, anytime after 3PM or at our booth at the Orangeville Farmer's Market on Saturday's between 8AM and 1PM. We hope this will make pick-ups more convenient for you.

We are also making some changes to the Membership process for 2008. Most importantly, we are inviting all new and returning CSA Members to attend an Orientation Sessions in the spring to learn more about the CSA model and the Whole Village Farm. The Orientation Sessions will be held on the following dates:

The CSA model is about connecting eaters with the farmers that grow their food and the land where that food is grown. With this goal in mind, we are happy to offer CSA Members the opportunity to come out and work in the garden during the Whole Village work bees that take place each month between 10:00 and 4:00 on the following dates:

Annual Payment:

o Cheque in amount of \$500 with current date.

Bi-annual Payments:

- Deposit cheque in amount of \$250 with current date.
- Second cheque in amount of \$250 post-dated for August 1st.

Monthly Payments:

- Deposit cheque in amount of \$100 with current date.
- 4 cheques in amount of \$100 postdated for July, August, September and October 1st.

Large Share:

Annual Payment:

o Cheque in amount of \$700 with current date.

Bi-annual Payments:

- Deposit cheque in amount of \$350 with current date.
- Second cheque in amount of \$350 post-dated for August 1st.

Monthly Payments:

- Deposit cheque in amount of \$140 with current date.
- 4 cheques in amount of \$140 postdated for July, August, September and October 1st.

Please Note:

- We prefer payment by cheque. Please make cheque payable to: Whole Village.
- Please date deposits for the day they are written NOT the first day of pick-up. We use this early income to cover spring capital costs like seed and equipment purchases.
- Deposits received without post-dated cheques for the full amount of the Membership fee will not be accepted.

- **Step 2:** Call or e-mail us to confirm your CSA Membership for 2008 before May 9th.
- **Step 3:** Complete the Membership Application Form and submit it, along with your payment before May 9th. We have a waiting list, so send your payment in **ASAP.**
- **Step 4**: Attend an Orientation day of your choice. See the News and Events section for details.
- **Step 5**: Pick up a copy of the Member Guide at the Orientation and read it before your first pick-up day.
- **Step 7**: Pick up your first share at the farm on June 17th or at the Orangeville Market on June 21st.
- **Step 8:** Pick up and enjoy your fresh, delicious, organic vegetables each week!
